

Alternate Routes for 9G Bridge Closure

The DOT will be closing the Roeliff Jansen Kill Bridge on Route 9G in Columbia County, starting Monday, April 19th. The bridge will be closed for repairs, with an anticipated reopening in October, 2010.

Obviously, this creates problems for Clermont, as traffic coming from the north will be detoured. The DOT recommends the following route:
When coming from the south on 9G or across the Rhinebeck-Kingston Bridge no detours are needed.

When coming from the north on 9G or across the Rip Van Winkle Bridge:

- Take Route 23 East
- Turn right onto Route 9 South
- Follow Route 9 until south of Red Hook where it merges with 9G
- Take 9G North to Clermont

The route should be marked with Detour signs once construction starts.
