## Rockefeller State Park Preserve

---

### General rules:

- Individuals under the age of 16 do not require a fishing license.
- Those individuals above the age of 16 require a New York State fishing license, which can be obtained at [www.dec.ny.gov](http://www.dec.ny.gov).
- Be conscious that contaminants, pollution, harmful bacterial, and excess nutrients may be present within certain bodies of water, including those within our preserve. Adhere to DEC guidelines on safety consumption limits and perform due diligence to consider the risks of consuming any fish which are caught.

### Preserve rules:

- **Register your fishing license with our staff at the preserve's main office for your first session of the season.** Office hours are 8:30AM through 4:30PM, year-round, 7 days a week (excluding holidays). After you register your license for your first session of the season, you do not have to 'check-in' at the office for subsequent sessions.
- **We strongly recommend adhering to a 'catch & release' policy in the preserve.** In the event that you intend to keep your fish, please adhere to specific size limits and seasonal constraints for each species.
- **Only artificial lures are allowed** in all RSPP waterbodies. No chumming or use of bait fish, live or dead, is allowed. No lines are allowed to be set overnight. **Do not leave behind any fishing line or gear.**
- **No ice fishing is allowed.**
- The information below is only a summary of state and county fishing guidelines, *not* a comprehensive list. **As the angler, you are responsible for understanding all the federal, state, and county regulations.** Information on state and county regulations can be found at: [www.dec.ny.gov/outdoor/7917.html](http://www.dec.ny.gov/outdoor/7917.html).
